1. Position Summary

Due to the university's ongoing expansion, we are recruiting a part-time lecturer for Macroeconomics. A Fixed-Duration Contract (FDC) will be offered. Contracts may then be extended until the end of the academic year and possibly beyond.

The Macroeconomic part-time lecturer is responsible for teaching and developing teaching materials for the Macroeconomics course. The ideal candidate should have a strong academic background in Economics, Finance, and Business and Management (with Economic focus) and experience teaching at the university level.

2. Duties & Responsibilities

The overall job description below outlines the main areas of responsibilities of the Employee:

- 3 hours per week, a total of 45 hours of Student Contact Hours (SCH) for the entire course. SCH for lecturers is agreed upon consultation with the Head of the Faculty
- Providing teaching for the students of the Bachelor of Arts in English, Business, and Entrepreneurship
- Preparation of lessons, exams, and assessments for both synchronous and asynchronous modes of delivery
